*"[God] Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us..."* **2 Corinthians 1:10**

God has delivered (past tense) us from a great death in depravity, referring to the New Birth. He also 'doth' deliver us (present tense), referring to daily deliverance from many ills such as error and sinfulness while we live here. And yet, we trust that one day He will deliver us (future tense) from the presence sin and death itself in Heaven.

A study note, the word 'Deliver' is a synonym for the word 'Save.'" Deliverance is salvation. (Compare Joel 2:32 with Acts 2:21 in a KJV.)
